



Student Company Program Details: Soloist

Age: 13 (by Dance+ Audition Date) through 19

Level: Ballet 5 or Higher | Pointe: Enrolled in Pointe 3 or Higher | Modern: Enrolled in Modern 3 or Higher

Description:

The Student Company at Northern Plains Dance (NPD) aims to amplify and celebrate students' commitment to their dance training and performance quality. As such, Student Company members are invited to make a commitment to the 2025/26 school year (August-May) to receive exclusive discounts and benefits. Student Company members are expected to train year-round and perform in NPD productions. They will also serve as NPD ambassadors both inside and outside the studio, acting as role models for younger dancers, performing at community events, and actively participating in fundraising efforts. Student Company members will work closely with the faculty to achieve their individual goals in dance.

Performance Commitment:

- Participation in The Nutcracker (December 13-15), Dance+ (February 20 & 21), and The Wizard of Oz (May 8-10) as set forth in the casting agreements for each production, abiding by all rules.
- It is recommended that members of the Soloist Company also participate in the Youth Ensemble performance (Friday, March 13).

Enrollment Requirements:

- A minimum of three ballet technique* classes per week at NPD
- A minimum of one modern technique class per week at NPD
- A minimum of one pointe technique* class per week at NPD
- Additional Saturday warm-up** classes and theater warm-up classes
- Demonstrate a history of hard work, commitment, and dedication while attending technique classes and rehearsals with a positive attitude.

*Rehearsals are not considered technique classes.

**Saturday warm-up refers to the AM Saturday class prior to rehearsal, which is required for all Company members when NPD is in production. Company members may NOT use warm-up to substitute a required technique class or use warm-up as a makeup class. Warm-up is not limited to Company members.

Perks:

- An individual headshot of each Soloist Company will be featured in the performance playbill for Dance+, The Nutcracker and The Wizard of Oz.
- Exclusive Student Company merchandise/apparel
- Invitation to events specifically for Student Company members
- Class & Workshop Discounts (outlined below)
- No fees with Casting Agreements for the included performances – these are included in your dues.
- Free and/or Discounted Workshops throughout the year
- No guest choreographer fees
- Admission for your dancer to cast parties of the included performances.
- The ability to fundraise against your Company dues.
- Discounts on Summer Youth Ensemble fees.
- No need to fight for Volunteer hours!



Company Dues:

Soloist Company dues will be split into **9** equal payments of **\$192** and will be charged to your card on file the first week of September, October, November, December, January, February, March, April and May. Attend the Student Company Meeting/Info Session for more details.

Offsetting Dues by Fundraising:

To make Company participation financially possible for all NPD students, Company students and families have the option to fundraise throughout the year. You may offset your Company dues by participating in any or all the options below. Any funds raised through these methods will be taken off the following month(s) dues. Any other donations of money, goods or services outside of the options listed below will not count towards fundraising totals.

Fundraiser option for Soloist Company:

- \$10,000x200 will be figured at 75%. Example: If a check is received in your honor for \$100, you will be given credit for \$75.
- Giving Hearts Day will be figured at 75% according to the name in the dedication box. Example: If a donation is made in your name for \$100, you will be given credit for \$75. **if your name is not prominent in the donation, we will not count this as fundraising on your behalf. **
- Bacon for Ballet will be figured \$3.75 per bag. Example: If you sell 100 items, you will be given credit for \$375.
- Nuts & Candy will be figured at \$3.75 per bag. Example: If you sell 100 bags of goodies, you will be given credit for \$375.

Alternative method for students:

If a student is over the age of 14, they may be asked to lead birthday parties, serve as a classroom assistant or help teach camps throughout the year. If a student is asked to participate in one of these activities, they will have the option to be paid outright or to have their earnings credited towards their company dues; this decision must be made when signing Company paperwork and cannot be changed throughout the year. Any credits earned in the current school year will be applied to the current year's dues. Any credits earned between the last day of Academy classes and the start of the following school year will be applied to the following year's dues.

Mentorship Requirements:

One purpose of the Student Company is to provide positive student leadership within NPD. To do so, Soloist Company members are asked to do the following:

- Assist in the classroom (e.g: adaptive dance) and rehearsals for The Nutcracker and/or The Wizard of Oz as needed. For example, if you are assigned to be the Cherubs' assistant you will attend all possible rehearsals for that role, keeping in mind that your own casting takes priority but consistency for the young ones is of the utmost importance. As a positive role model to these young dancers, you will be a shining example to parents of what NPD has to offer.
- Respect the space. Company members are expected to do their part in keeping the facility presentable without being asked. This includes taking out the trash when it is full, picking up food waste, etc. This will demonstrate to the younger students and parents that you take pride in NPD, and you are willing to help keep the building looking good.
- Treat the Director, teachers, choreographers, guests and fellow company members in a respectful manner, both in and outside the studio (please look at our policy on social media and bullying as listed in our handbook)



Volunteer Requirements:

- Parents of Company Members are required to complete the designated Volunteer Activities to receive credit towards their Volunteer Fees. NPD has split the season into 5 sections; Nutcracker, Dance+, Misc Spring (to include Tiny Tots & Student Showcase), Wizard of Oz, Summer. NPD staff will assign parents to assist with forward-facing tasks during these times, such as overseeing auditions, studio dress, cast party, tea party or will call. NPD will be respectful of your dancer(s) commitment level and will make best efforts to assign tasks that are relevant to your family. As a Student Company parent, you are "excused" from traditional Production Volunteer Hours. However, you are still expected to help when asked, even if the hours seem to coincide with Production Volunteer Hours. Failure to fulfill assigned duties will result in a \$75 charge to the card on file per offense.
- Company members are required to:
 - Sew closures and nametags on their own costumes for each production and have it checked by a staff member within one week of fitting.
 - Participate in outreach efforts and additional performances throughout the year as they arise.
 - Assist with one Special Event and one Theater Activity as assigned. All activities must be completed at the designated time, substitution is not allowed. Assistance by students at the following events will not count towards volunteer hours required for other NPD activities (performance, scholarship). Examples of these are:
 - Zoo Boo (a Saturday in October during Saturday rehearsal)
 - Move-In for The Nutcracker (Sunday prior to Production Week)
 - Move-In for Dance+ (Sunday prior to Production Week TBD)
 - Prince Charming Ball (Early March)
 - Butterfly Ball (Late March)
 - Move-In for The Wizard of Oz (Sunday prior to Production Week)
 - Giving Hearts Day thank you letters (picked up the day after GHD and returned the following Monday)

Summer Performances:

Throughout the summer, NPD is asked to perform at a series of outdoor events, typically Kids Summer Stage (two Wednesdays in late June-July), Family River Walk (one Wednesday in July), Mandan Library (one Weekday in July), Bismarck Library (two weekdays in July), Capital A'Fair (one Saturday or Sunday in August) and BisMarket (one Saturday in August). Company members are strongly encouraged to participate in the Summer Youth Ensemble. If members choose to perform and are available for at least 50% of the performance dates; NPD will waive the Summer Youth Ensemble fee if the dancer is enrolled in a minimum of 1 other technique class. NPD reserves the right to cast each performance as necessary to ensure that each Company member gets a chance to perform. Company members are expected to perform in the Relevé on the Rooftop event if they are available.

Additional Requirements:

- Follow all rules set forth in the handbook including, but not limited to, dress codes.
- Attend Student Company meetings
 - October 2 (subject to change)
 - January 22 (subject to change)
- One unexcused absence per class per quarter is allowed. Student Company members are expected to make up any absences.
- Any violation of the above will result in a meeting with a faculty member to discuss appropriate next steps.
- NPD Staff and Faculty reserve the right to void the tuition discount (see below), increase company dues and dismiss a company member in case of repeated violations of the requirements and expectations.

Requirements for Consideration in Subsequent Years:

- Complete the previous year of Company membership in good standing; attend required technique classes and rehearsals with a positive attitude.



- Continue dance studies over the summer months as discuss and approved by the NPD Faculty.
- Show the ability and desire to act as a role model and mentor to younger students throughout all levels of NPD.
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Tuition Discount:

- Student Company members will receive an additional tuition discount of 5% for all non-required classes (i.e. contemporary, cross training, etc).
 - If you are currently receiving another discount, i.e. sibling discount, the greater of the two will be applied. Both discounts cannot be applied to the same bill
- The first discounts will be applied to student's account and used towards the next scheduled tuition payment.
- Credits remaining at the end of the summer will be voided and cannot be applied to the 2026-27 school year.

Audition Discount:

- Members of the Soloist Company will receive a \$100 discount on audition video sessions.
- Members of the Soloist Company will receive one headshot photo and one full body photo (e.g: first arabesque) for free.

Workshop Discounts

- Winter Workshops taught by NPD faculty are offered at no charge.
- Workshops offered by Guest Faculty will be offered at a 35% discount
- Summer Dance Intensive Discount:
 - Members of the Soloist Company will receive a \$100 discount if you sign up for both full sessions.
 - If early bird registration discount is used, you will receive the greater of the two discounts not both.
 - Not eligible for drop-in classes.

Withdrawal from Student Company:

If circumstances arise that make it so the dancer cannot fulfill their commitment, the following Withdrawal Fees will apply and will be charged to the card on file when the Drop Form is received:

- Tuition Discount: Any tuition discount that has been used as of the date of withdrawal.
- Advanced Role Fee: This will be charged at the rate listed in the handbook and will be prorated for any classes taken if the withdrawal date is mid-production. (Minus any dues paid)
- Guest Choreographers: This will be charged at the rate listed in the handbook.
- Cast Party Admission: Any admissions to the eligible cast parties as of the date of withdrawal.
- Student Company Merchandise: Any merchandise given to the dancer as of the date of withdrawal will be charged at retail price.
- Photography Fee: \$75 will be charged to cover the cost of the initial photos published in all performance programs.
- Workshop Fees: Any workshops attended free of charge or at a discounted rate as of the date of withdrawal.
